## TXDOT STEP Grant for FY 2025

The Police Department successfully applied for and received a one-year traffic safety grant from the Texas Department of Transportation.

This grant, part of the Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP), funds law enforcement overtime efforts to decrease incidents of speeding, driving under the influence, failure to use seatbelts, intersection traffic violations, and violations of state and local regulations on cell phone use and texting while driving. 3

This grant will provide \$56,497.45 in funding, which will be used for overtime efforts aimed at promoting traffic safety, reducing accidents, and improving the safety of Killeen's roads.
