Background

- Annually the Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office, administers the statewide Homeland Security Grant program (HSGP).
- Funds are intended to improve our ability to prevent, protect, mitigate, respond, and recover to threats and hazards.
- The Office of the Governor facilitated a competitive application process through the Council of Government agencies in the State

 - the CodeRED Emergency Notification System
 - the "If You See Something, Say Something®" campaign
- These informational campaigns will promote resilience and providing continuity education to the community
- Our awarded project number is 4845101 from the TX OOG

- Grant application amount is \$5,000.00
- No matching funds and positive financial impact
