Background and Findings

- ❑ On January 20th, 2026 the city council approved an interlocal agreement for the bidding and construction of the Bell County Chaparral Road Traffic Signals project.
- ❑ In accordance with the agreement Bell County will reimburse the cost of construction to the City of Killeen.
- ❑ The City will be responsible for construction monitoring and maintenance of the signals.

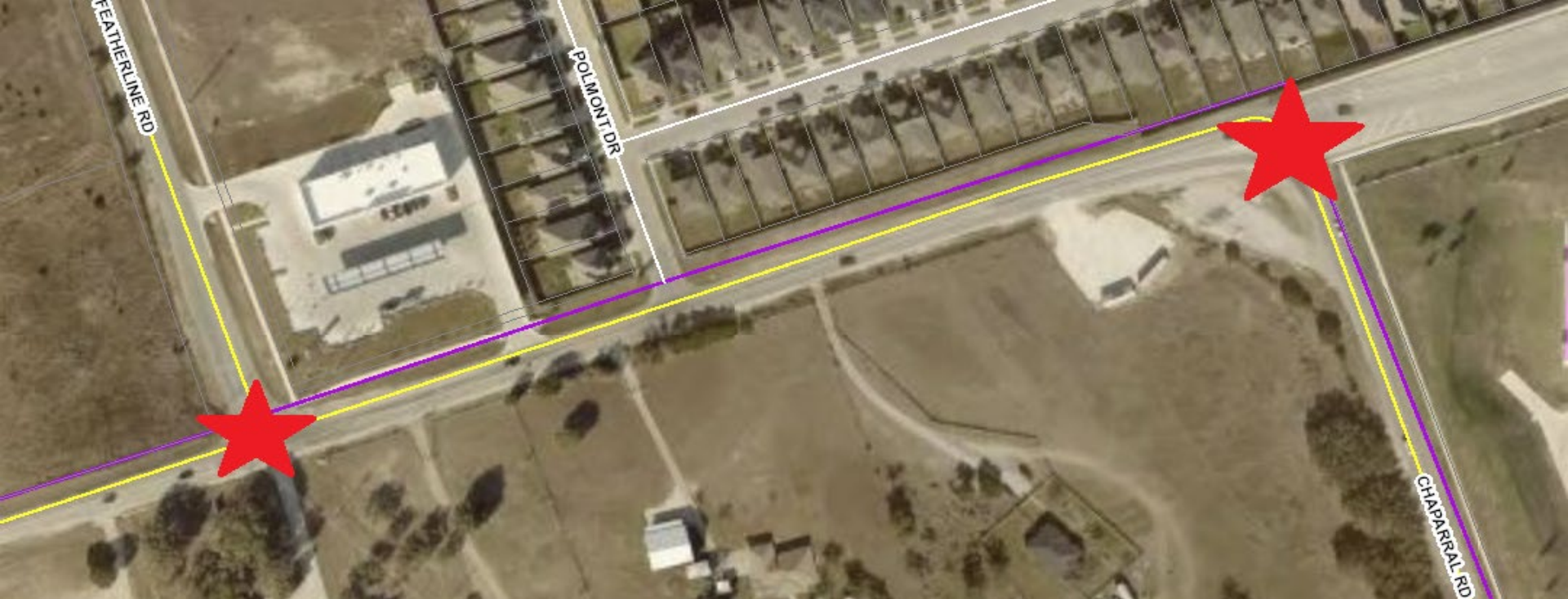
Background and Findings

- The traffic signals to be constructed will be span wires and poles. The traffic cabinets will be installed in the permanent locations that correspond with the future widening project for Chaparral Road.
- At the time of the Chaparral Road Widening project, the span wire signals will be replaced with steel poles and mast arms.
- Bid were opened April 29, 2026 were opened and read aloud on zoom.

Background and Findings

- ATSCC was the lowest qualified bidder for the project.
- The city verified the references for this contractor with very positive results. ATSCC has also worked with the City in the past with good results.
- The Design Engineer reviewed and provided recommendation to award the project to ATSCC.

Recommendation

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- Authorize the award of Bid No. 26-22, Chaparral Road Traffic Signals to ATSCC, authorize the City Manager, or designee, to execute a construction contract in the amount of \$420,000.00 with ATSCC and furthermore, authorize the City Manager, or designee, to execute any and all change orders within the amounts set by State and Local law.
