Background

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- ❑ New chassis received and ready for crane body
- ❑ Obtained two of four solicited quotes for:
 - ❑ \$119,537.60 from Silsbee Ford with six-week delivery
 - ❑ \$126,850.00 from Caldwell Country Chevrolet with ten-month delivery
 - ❑ Grapevine Dodge – no quote received
 - ❑ Rush Trucks – no quote received

Procurement Information

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- ❑ Staff recommends purchase from Silsbee Ford
- ❑ Silsbee Ford is part of The Interlocal Purchasing System (TIPS) Cooperative
- ❑ Total cost of new crane body is \$119,537.60
 - ❑ Budget available for crane body \$79,390
 - ❑ Additional funding required in mid-year budget amendment of \$40,148 from CIP contingency

Water & Sewer Currently Using

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- ❑ Unit 566 is undersized
- ❑ 16 years old with 171,000 miles
- ❑ \$74,587 repair & maintenance cost thus far
- ❑ Replacement chassis was ordered December 2021 (FY 2022)

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Recommendation

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Staff recommends City Council authorize the purchase of the crane body for the Public Works Water Distribution Division from Silsbee Ford in the amount of \$119,537.60, and that the City Manager or designee be authorized to execute any and all change orders as permitted by state and local law
