





2023 – 2024 Marijuana Suspects by Gender Comparison




2023 – 2024 Marijuana Arrests by Gender Comparison




2023 – 2024 Marijuana Suspects by Race/Ethnicity Comparison




2023 – 2024 Marijuana Arrests by Race/Ethnicity Comparison




2023 – 2024 Marijuana Charges Comparison

Chief of Police Advisory Board Meeting

On March 19, 2025, the Chief of Police Advisory Board met to discuss the 2024 Marijuana incidents.

Meeting focused on addressing disparities in marijuana arrests.

 Advisory Board and Chief discussed potential alternatives to criminal enforcement.

Led to a consensus on exploring a Marijuana Diversion Program.

Proposed Marijuana Diversion Program

Program aims to reduce low-level marijuana arrests, especially among minority populations.

Would divert eligible individuals into education, treatment, or civil citation pathways.

 Next steps include coordination with the County Attorney for a legal review and community engagement.
