






2023 – 2024 Marijuana Suspects by Gender Comparison


2023 – 2024 Marijuana Arrests by Gender Comparison


2023 – 2024 Marijuana Suspects by Race/Ethnicity Comparison


2023 – 2024 Marijuana Arrests by Race/Ethnicity Comparison


2023 – 2024 Marijuana Charges Comparison



Chief of Police Advisory Board Meeting

- ❑ On March 19, 2025, the Chief of Police Advisory Board met to discuss the 2024 Marijuana incidents.
- ❑ Meeting focused on addressing disparities in marijuana arrests.
- ❑ Advisory Board and Chief discussed potential alternatives to criminal enforcement.
- ❑ Led to a consensus on exploring a Marijuana Diversion Program.

Proposed Marijuana Diversion Program

10

- Program aims to reduce low-level marijuana arrests, especially among minority populations.
- Would divert eligible individuals into education, treatment, or civil citation pathways.
- Next steps include coordination with the County Attorney for a legal review and community engagement.
