AWARD BID NO. 25-15 INCINERATOR

- Animal Services provides many services to the Killeen and Fort Cavazos community such as; adoption services, care for sick or injured animals, as well as having to dispose of deceased animals at times.
- The current incinerator is 17 years old, has gone beyond its life span, and no longer works as parts are no longer available. Issues began in FY 2023 which included:
 - High gas bills
 - Long processing times up to 72 hours
- Currently staff is making multiple trips to the Temple landfill to properly dispose of deceased animals in a timely manner, this takes staff away from the animals and citizens who require our services.
 - Cost for this type of disposal is approximately \$52,000 annually.

Background Cont.

- The new equipment will also be utilized by the Killeen Police Department's Evidence Processing Unit (EPU) for narcotics disposal.
 - Currently, the EPU must transport narcotics to the Amlon Group in Baytown,
 Texas.
 - In 2024, only two deliveries were made to the Amlon Group with the cost of the drug burns totaling \$4,427.50.
 - These deliveries require at least two to three officers to provide escort with two EPU personnel to ensure proper destruction.
 - A minimum of two vehicles are required for the deliveries and the estimated staff time is \$1400 per trip.
 - By deploying officers for drug deliveries, personnel available for patrol operations can be negatively impacted for the day.

Background Cont.

- Purchase of a new incinerator was approved in FY 2024.
- On January 30, 2025, Purchasing received one response to Bid No.
 25-15, Animal Services Incinerator from American Incinerators Corp in the amount of \$185,500.
- Receiving the new equipment would be beneficial for several reasons.
 - Completion time of three (3) hours.
 - Minimal trips to the landfill for disposal of deceased animals.
 - Provides separate incineration compartments allowing Animal Services to offer cremation services for the public.
 - Saves PD staff time and costs for incineration of drugs in Baytown, TX, keeping more officers in Killeen.
