Background

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- The Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) signed into law on November 15, 2021, provides \$15 billion in Airport Infrastructure Grants (AIG) over a five (5) year period for airport-related projects as defined under the existing Airport Improvement Grant and Passenger Facility Charge (PFC) criteria.

Background

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- ❑ The City has been offered a Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) BIL Airport Infrastructure Grant in the amount of \$108,810 to fund 90% of the design of the Security Improvements Project at the Killeen-Fort Hood Regional Airport (KFHRA). Matching funds, in the amount of \$12,090, will come from the FAA PFC Application that was approved by the FAA on February 16, 2023.
- ❑ No impact to the operational fund or fund balance.
