Approval of Agenda

Ordinances / Resolutions

OR-14-017 Consider an ordinance canvassing the returns and declaring results of May 10, 2014 General Election.

The City Secretary read the caption of the ordinance.

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KILLEEN, TEXAS, CANVASSING RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF A GENERAL ELECTION HELD MAY 10, 2014 FOR THE ELECTION OF A MAYOR AND THREE COUNCILMEMBERS AT LARGE.

Councilmember Clark, Councilmember Gilmore, and Councilmember Segarra reviewed the election returns prior to the meeting for verification and accuracy. Councilmember Clark, acting as chairman, read the returns of the election stating the total votes each candidate received and reading Scott Cospers as the winning candidate for Mayor and Elizabeth Blackstone, Jonathan Okray, and Juan Rivera as the winning candidates for Councilmembers-at-Large.
