

INTERGOVERNMENTAL SUPPORT AGREEMENT EQUIPMENT PURCHASE

- On June 18, 2024, The City Council approved a resolution allowing the City of Killeen to enter into an Intergovernmental Support Agreement (IGSA) with Fort Cavazos to provide new and expanded airfield maintenance services for Robert Gray Army Airfield (RGAAF) and Yoakum Defrenn Army Heliport (YDAH).
- □ IGSA becomes effective October 1, 2024.

- The Aviation Department is seeking authorization to purchase equipment and vehicles needed to meet the requirements of the new IGSA, utilizing various cooperative resources.
- □ The purchase of goods or services made through cooperative contracts are exempt from the competitive bidding process as stated in Texas Local Government Code (TLGC) section 271.02, subchapter F and TLGC section 252.022.
