
Background and Findings

- On December 15, 2020, the City Council directed staff to review the transferring a portion of the Georgetown CCN within the City of Killeen Extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ).
- Since August 2021, the City has been working with Freese and Nichols, Inc. (FNI) to evaluate water infrastructure needs to extend the City's service area south into the current Georgetown Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN).
- On March 21, 2023, city staff briefed Council on the results of this evaluation and Council gave a Motion of Direction to move forward on a future CCN transfer.

- On August 20, 2025, Georgetown briefed Killeen on their CCN Transfer Project.
 - Georgetown proposed to sell to Killeen a large portion of their northern CCN that includes 27.4 miles of pipe and 256 customers.
 - Killeen offered to enter discussions for a smaller area of Georgetown's CCN that is identical to Killeen's proposed 2023 CCN area.
 - Georgetown is working with NewGen to do an analysis for Killeen's proposed CCN area.
 - Georgetown will then prepare the transfer agreement and both Georgetown and Killeen can bring the agreement to their councils.
 - The City is currently waiting on the City of Georgetown to forward documents.
