

ORDINANCE _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KILLEEN BY CHANGING THE ZONING OF CERTAIN PROPERTY OUT OF THE CITY OF KILLEEN, BELL COUNTY, TEXAS, FROM B-2 (LOCAL RETAIL DISTRICT) AND B-5 (BUSINESS DISTRICT) TO R-2 (TWO-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT); PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Bok Suk Baldwin has presented to the City of Killeen a request for amendment of the zoning ordinance of the City of Killeen by changing the classification of Lots 1-16, Block 1, Gentle Grove Addition, Phase Three, from B-2 (Local Retail District) and B-5 (Business District) to R-2 (Two-Family Residential District), said request having been duly presented and recommended for approval of R-2 zoning by the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Killeen, on the 21st day of April 2014, and due notice of the filing of said request and the date of hearing thereon was given as required by law, and hearing on said request was set for 5:00 P.M., on the 13th day of May 2014, at the City Hall, City of Killeen;

WHEREAS, the City Council considered said request at the regularly scheduled meeting of May 13, 2014, the action of the Planning and Zoning Commission and the evidence in support thereof, and the City Council being of the majority opinion that the request should be approved;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KILLEEN:

Section I. That the zoning classification for Lots 1-16, Block 1, Gentle Grove Addition, Phase Three, be changed from B-2 (Local Retail District) and B-5 (Business District) to R-2 (Two-Family Residential District). The property is located east of Old FM 440, across from Anna Lee Drive Killeen, Texas.

Section II. That should any section or part of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, it shall not invalidate or impair the validity, force, or effect of any other section or parts of this ordinance.

Section III. That all ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section IV. That the Code of Ordinances of the City of Killeen, Texas, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect, save and except as amended by this ordinance.

Section V. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage of the ordinance.
