

REPLACEMENT SPLIT CASE PUMPS (3) AT PUMP STATION #5

Background and Findings

- □ Pumps have a life cycle of 10 − 20 years, are made up of many parts and are critical to the water/wastewater infrastructure system to move fluids from one location to another.
- Staff went out for a multi-year bid for pump replacements within two (2) pump stations and twelve (12) lift stations that have all exceeded their life cycle.
 - On February 6, 2025, Purchasing received one (1) response for bid 25-16, Multi-Pump Replacements.
 - On March 18, 2025, City Council approved the rejection of the received response

- On March 14, 2025, Water & Sewer received a quote for replacement and installation of three (3) split case pumps at Pump Station #5 from Pump Solutions, Inc. through The Interlocal Purchasing System (TIPS) in the amount of \$135,000.
