



INTERGOVERNMENTAL SUPPORT AGREEMENT WITH
THE U.S. ARMY GARRISON FOR INSTALLATION
SUPPORT SERVICES AT FORT CAVAZOS

Background

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- On December 18, 2018, City Council approved an Intergovernmental Support Agreement (IGSA) with Fort Hood for airfield pavement maintenance at Robert Gray Army Airfield (RGAAF).
- This agreement included crack sealing, re-marking and minor pavement repairs on the runway, taxiways, and aprons.

Discussion

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- ❑ Aviation staff has negotiated a new IGSA with Fort Cavazos.
- ❑ Under the new agreement, Aviation Department staff would provide a range of support services including pavement maintenance, grounds maintenance, fencing repairs, and airfield electrical work at both RGAAF and Yoakum-DeFrenn Army Heliport.
- ❑ The agreement also provides funding for major equipment purchases.

Discussion

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- ❑ The agreement is for an initial one-year term at \$2,955,000, with the option to renew annually for up to nine additional years.
- ❑ Each additional one-year term includes a cost escalation.
- ❑ This IGSA was a collaborative effort between Aviation Department and Fort Cavazos staff and will be highly beneficial for both the City and Fort Cavazos.

Recommendation

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- Approve an Intergovernmental Support Agreement with the U.S. Army Garrison at Fort Cavazos, Texas, and authorize the City Manager or designee to execute same, as well as any and all amendments as allowed per federal, state, or local law.
