

ORDINANCE _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KILLEEN, TEXAS AMENDING THE FY 2013-2014 ANNUAL BUDGET AND PLAN OF MUNICIPAL SERVICES OF THE CITY OF KILLEEN BY RELEASING FUNDING FOR AN INCREASE IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT ACCOUNTS TOTALING \$54,400; PROVIDING SUFFICIENT FUNDING FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF FNH USA FN-15 RIFLES AND ACCESSORIES; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, The Killeen Police Department is planning the procurement of Patrol rifle/carbines to enable police first responders to engage the criminal element, with their ever increasing superior firepower in the safest and most prepared manner possible; and

WHEREAS, funding is available in the State Seizure Account maintained by the City of Killeen through the Killeen Police Department in compliance with Chapter 59 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure; and

WHEREAS, compliance with expenditure requirements will be met prior to procurement and with the release of funds authorized;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KILLEEN:

SECTION I. That Ordinance 13-067 adopting a budget for operating the municipal government of the City of Killeen for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2013 to September 30, 2014, be amended as to the portion of said budget as follows,

SECTION II. That the City Council finds that the public notice and the public hearing requirements of Section 56 of the City Charter have been complied with prior to the enactment of this ordinance.

SECTION III. That should any section or part of any section or paragraph of this ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional for any reason, it shall not invalidate or impair the validity, force or effect of any other section or sections or part of a section or paragraph of this ordinance.

SECTION IV. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION V. That this ordinance shall be effective after its passage and publication according to the law.
