Background


- The Cultural District Designation is awarded by the Texas Commission on the Arts (TCA).
- Cultural districts are designated zones that make use of cultural resources to stimulate economic development and community vitality.
- According to the TCA website, "The cultural district designation is most likely to be awarded to a district that is already defined in terms of leadership, geographic boundaries, branding, and current assets."

- Goals of a Cultural District may include:
 - Fostering local cultural development.
 - Attracting artists and cultural enterprises to the community.
 - Encouraging business and job development based on cultural attractions.
 - Addressing specific needs of a community utilizing its unique assets.

Successful Cultural Districts

- Factors that contribute to a successful Cultural District include:
 - A unique and authentic identity highlighting the distinctiveness of the community.
 - Engaging artists as partners.
 - Sustainable artist work/live spaces.
 - Strategic planning that provides a vision and path for the cultural district.
 - Anchor institutions, special events, and strong amenities.

Application Timeline



- The initial phase of this program will require at least
 2 years of planning and community engagement.
- Staff recommends that the City of Killeen re-evaluate the opportunity to apply for the Texas Cultural District in 2026.
