PFC NONPROFIT YOUTH ORGANIZATION GRANT

Background

- City Council allocated \$350,000 for youth nonprofit grants from Public Facility Corporation (PFC) funds
- Maximum of \$10,000 per nonprofit
- Nine organizations were approved for funding in first round (PFC \$90,000)
- Eleven organizations were approved in the second round (PFC \$110,000)
- One organization was approved through the ARPA nonprofit grant application process
 - Council authorized funding through PFC grant after all ARPA nonprofit funds were allocated
- \$140,000 remaining of the allocated \$350,000

Background (cont.)

- On December 1, 2022, City Council reopened the application process for youth nonprofits for 90 days, closing on February 28, 2023
- In accordance with state law, City Council must declare a public purpose for the expenditure of funds
 - Funds may not benefit private parties
 - City must maintain control of funds to ensure that a public purpose was met
 - Previous criteria used to qualify for funding
 - Must be an established nonprofit through the IRS
 - Must have been in existence prior to March 2020
 - Must fulfill a public purpose
 - Must have a complete application

Selected Applicants

- Seven application were selected to be funded for \$10,000 each:
 - 1. Better Opportunities Shoemaker Students (BOSS) Mentor Program
 - 2. She is Priceless
 - Alberta L. Barrett/ARK2Freedom
 - Killeen Christian Broadcasting Corporation,
 - 5. Clements Boys and Gils Clubs affiliate of Boys and Girls Clubs of Central Texas
 - 6. The Central Texas Herencia Foundation
 - 7. Pearls of Services Foundation of Central Texas

- Do not approve the funding for seven nonprofit youth organizations.
- Amend the selected organizations.
- Approve the funding, declare the public purpose and authorize staff to execute the agreements for the seven nonprofit youth organizations.

Declare the public purpose and approve the grant funding requests for seven nonprofit youth organizations in an amount not to exceed \$10,000 for each organization and authorize staff to execute the agreements.
