

Background

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- ❑ FY 2022 Capital Improvement Plan includes ARPA funding for the design and construction of the Emergency Operation Center.
- ❑ On May 3, 2022 Council approved to use excess fund balance to fund construction of Fire Station #4.
- ❑ Ten firms submitted proposals which were reviewed and considered by city staff.
- ❑ Martinez Architects was selected for the design of the Emergency Operation Center/Fire Station #4 Complex project.
- ❑ Propose Contract for Engineering Design \$1,305,000.00

Alternatives Considered

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The City Council has two (2) alternatives. The Council may:
