

PURCHASE OF STRETCHER, LOADING SYSTEM, AND PRO-CARE FROM STRYKER SALES, LLC

- Background
  - The Killeen Fire Department utilizes Stryker Sales, LLC to purchase powered stretchers and load systems, which load the stretcher and patient into the ambulance with minimal lifting required, helping to prevent injury to personnel.
  - We elect to include Stryker ProCare with each new piece of equipment purchased; which is an extended warranty encompassing parts, labor, travel, maintenance, and batteries for each registered piece of equipment for up to 5 years (60 months).
  - This purchase will replace a Ferno stretcher which has exceeded its usable life expectancy.









- □ Financial Impact
  - Depending on the age of current equipment the fire department will request either 1 or 2 replacement systems each fiscal year. This year is for 1 system.
  - The FY 2025 expenditure will be an amount not to exceed \$80,865
  - Budgeted expense, no additional funding required
  - This process conforms to City Procurement Policy.

□ Staff recommends that the City Council authorize the request to purchase one Power Pro 2 Stretcher with Power Load system and the associated 5-year ProCare Preventive Maintenance Services and Parts from Stryker Sales, LLC in the total amount not to exceed \$80,865, and that the City Manager, or his designee, is expressly authorized to execute any and all change orders within the amounts set by State and Local Law.
