

## ORDINANCE \_\_\_\_\_

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KILLEEN BY CHANGING THE ZONING OF CERTAIN PROPERTY OUT OF THE CITY OF KILLEEN, BELL COUNTY, TEXAS, FROM “R-1” (SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT) TO “B-3” (LOCAL BUSINESS DISTRICT); PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, Murphy Oil USA, Inc. on behalf of Mark Stanford, has presented to the City of Killeen a request for amendment of the zoning ordinance of the City of Killeen by changing the classification of 1.615 acres out of the GW Farris Survey, Abstract No. 306, being locally known as 4701 Trimmier Road, Killeen, Texas, from “R-1” (Single-Family Residential District) to “B-3” (Local Business District), said request having been duly presented to the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Killeen on the 21st day of August 2017, with the Commission’s recommendation of the following:

1) Approval of “B-3” (Local Business District) zoning for the 1.6156 acres of property that is currently zoned as “R-1” (Single-Family Residential District).

Due notice of the filing of said request and the date of hearing thereon was given as required by law, and hearing on said request was set for 5:00 P.M., on the 12th day of September 2017, at the City Hall, City of Killeen;

**WHEREAS**, the City Council at said hearing duly considered said request, the action of the Planning and Zoning Commission and the evidence in support thereof, and the City Council being of the majority opinion that the applicant’s zoning request should be approved subject to the conditions as recommended by the Planning and Zoning

Commission;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF KILLEEN:**

**SECTION I.** That the zoning classification of 1.615 acres out of the GW Farris Survey, Abstract No. 306, being locally known as 4701 Trimmier Road, Killeen, Texas, be changed from “R-1” (Single-Family Residential District) to “B-3” (Local Business District).

**SECTION II.** That should any section or part of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, it shall not invalidate or impair the validity, force, or effect of any other section or parts of this ordinance.

**SECTION III.** That all ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION IV.** That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage of the ordinance.
