CONTRACT AGREEMENT WITH JAMAIL & SMITH CONSTRUCTION, LP, FOR THE TRANSFER STATION PUSH WALL REPAIR

February 18, 2025

Background

- On January 15, 2023 a fire occurred at the Transfer Station that damaged the steel plated push wall.
- The City entered into a letter of agreement with Freese and Nichols to design the repair needed for the push wall.
- The City advertised for bids to be due on September 4, 2024 and again on May 30, 2024. In both cases no bids were received.

- The City and Designer reached out to Jamail & Smith Construction LP, a Buyboard contractor, to work together to develop a proposal for the needed repairs.
- Jamail & Smith Construction LP submitted a contract proposal in the amount of \$ 202,702.03 to perform needed repairs.
- This repair project is being coordinated with Risk Management and the City's insurance company for funding towards this repair.

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the City Council authorize the execution of the agreement with the Jamail & Smith Construction, LP for the Transfer Station Push Wall Repair in the amount of \$202,702.03.
