Background

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- ❑ On January 15, 2023 a fire occurred at the Transfer Station that damaged the steel plated push wall.
- ❑ The City entered into a letter of agreement with Freese and Nichols to design the repair needed for the push wall.
- ❑ The City advertised for bids to be due on September 4, 2024 and again on May 30, 2024. In both cases no bids were received.

Background

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- The City and Designer reached out to Jamail & Smith Construction LP, a Buyboard contractor, to work together to develop a proposal for the needed repairs.
- Jamail & Smith Construction LP submitted a contract proposal in the amount of \$ 202,702.03 to perform needed repairs.
- This repair project is being coordinated with Risk Management and the City's insurance company for funding towards this repair.
