

TPWD LOCAL PARK GRANT
PROGRAM, NON-URBAN OUTDOOR

- Texas Parks & Wildlife Department (TPWD) Local Park Grant Program assists local governments with acquisition and/or development of recreation areas and facilities throughout the State of Texas. The Program provides 50% matching grants on a reimbursement basis to eligible applicants.
- This year TPWD is offering the Non-Urban Outdoor Grant Program. The application deadline is August 1, 2024, with awards announced in January 2025.

Background

The grant would pay for two projects:

- Fowler Park Playground Structure, sidewalks, curb ramps, crosswalks, signage, benches, water fountain, shade trees & irrigation. The estimated cost is \$192,000.
- Long Branch Park Resurface (1) existing tennis court to (4) new pickleball court surfaces, plated pickleball nets, net posts, sidewalk repair, & curb ramp. The estimated cost is \$25,000.

- □ The combined estimated cost for both projects is \$217,000, with the City providing a \$108,500 match.
- Matching funds are available in the 2023 certificate of obligation for parkland development.


