- Bidding Process
 - ▣ Advertising began on *May 19, 2022*
 - ▣ Bids opened on July 6, 2022
 - ▣ Only one (1) bid received

Vendor	NASCO
Base Bid	\$486,000.00
Deductive Alternate 1	-\$86,631.00

Discussion

- A thorough review of this bid package was completed by the airport's consultant and staff. The bid came in higher than what the FAA has approved for this project, therefore, the consultant and staff's recommendation is to reject the bid.
- FAA recommends re-bidding.
