

RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN AN AGREEMENT WITH THE FAA FOR AN AIP GRANT-TAXIWAY E RELOCATION PROJECT

July 2, 2024

Background

- A portion of Taxiway E at the Killeen Regional Airport (KRA) needs rehabilitation.
- Due to changes in Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) taxiway design standards, any rehabilitation to this taxiway requires relocation

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- □ The City applied for and received an FAA Airport Improvement Program (AIP) grant in the amount of \$407,903 on July 25, 2023, to be used for the design phase of this project.
- Project included administration, surveying services, geotechnical services, design services, bidding services, and other engineering fees for the relocation of Taxiway E at KRA.

Discussion

- The FAA has now notified the City that we will receive a grant for the construction phase of the Taxiway E Relocation project.
- The Grant will include funding from the AIP, FAA Discretionary, and Supplemental Discretionary funding supported by Congressman Pfluger.
- The actual grant will not be issued until after bids have been received and reviewed.
- Grant offer will then be based on the accepted bid amount.

Discussion

□ To comply with the FAA timeline requirements for returning signed grant offers, staff is requesting the City Council approve a resolution authorizing the City Manager, or designee, to execute the grant agreement and related documents pertaining to this grant offer.

- □ The grant will fund 90% of the cost. The 10% match will come from the FAA Passenger Facility Charge (PFC) Program Application that was approved by the FAA on February 16, 2023.
- No impact to the Aviation operational fund or fund balance.

Recommendation

□ City Council approve a resolution authorizing the City Manager, or designee, to execute any and all required documents, including all amendments, pertaining to the Federal Aviation Administration's Airport Improvement Program Grant for the Taxiway E Relocation project at Killeen Regional Airport.
