Background

- March 2023 City of Killeen conducted Biennial Citizen Survey
- Survey helps to assess input from community members as Council makes decisions on services and ensures Killeen's priorities are aligned with the needs of the residents
- Survey consisted of 33 questions (all responses are anonymous)
- Results of the 2023 survey were presented to City Council on June 13, 2023

2023 Survey Results

- □ 529 residents completed the survey
- 78% were satisfied or neutral with overall quality of life
- Highest Investment Priorities
 - Street maintenance
 - Police Services
 - Code Enforcement
