Background

2

- City Council allocated \$350,000 for nonprofits serving youth from Public Facility Corporation (PFC) funds
 - Original application process was open for submissions April 13 – May 12, 2022 and nine youth nonprofits were approved for funding = \$90,000
 - On June 21, 2022, City Council reopened the application process for the Nonprofit Youth Organizations for thirty days, closing July 21, 2022

Background-continued

3

- Thirteen applications were received. On July 25, 2022 City Council selected eleven applications for funding
- In accordance with state law, City Council must declare a public purpose for the expenditure of funds
 - Funds may not benefit private parties
 - City must maintain control of funds to ensure that a public purpose was met
