Bids for the above referenced project were received at 2:00 PM, Thursday, May 2 2024, at were publicly read aloud the same day and location. KSA Engineers has reviewed the bids and prepared a Bid Tabulation indicating the bid results. This Bid Tabulation is enclosed for your review. A total of three (3) bids were received, and all bidders submitted the required bid security. However, the highest bidder (B-5 Construction) did not submit multiple documents and can be considered non-responsive.

As shown in the bid tabulation, the low bidder is SSP Industries, in the following amount:

Base Bid – \$1,215,098.00

KSA reviewed information submitted by the low bidder, the list of similar project experience provided, and references contacted, all responses were positive. Based upon this information, SSP Industries appears to be qualified to perform the work required.

If the City of Killeen awards this contract, our office will issue a notice of award to the low bidder and prepare Construction Contract Documents for execution by the Contractor and the City of Killeen. KSA looks forward to working with the City during the construction phase on this important project to ensure a quality job.

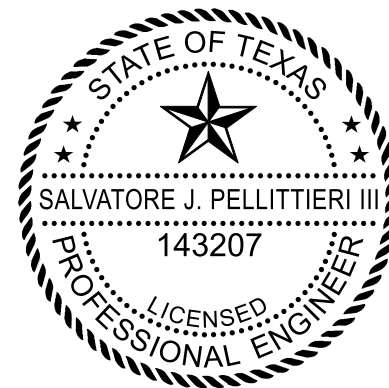
