Background

- Hill Country Community Action Agency (HCCAA)
 provides nutritious meals to income eligible seniors
 through the Killeen Meals on Wheels program.
- The Killeen senior meals program serves over 300 unduplicated clients annually.
- The program is currently operating out of a city-owned (previously donated) WWII army barracks that has far exceeded its useful life, is in disrepair, and not economically feasible to renovate.

- Council authorized an award through the adopted City of Killeen American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Potential Uses for HCCAA in the amount of \$200,000.00 for the Meals on Wheels project.
- Through collaborative partnerships, the Killeen program will relocate preparation and staging operations to the Avanti Legacy Parkview (ALP) affordable senior housing commercial kitchen upon completion of construction.

The HCCAA ARPA agreement will provide funding in an amount of \$196,964.21 for the procurement of commercial kitchen equipment to operate in the ALP kitchen.

Procurement Process

- HCCAA received three quotes for commercial kitchen equipment
 - □ First Bid Info
 - Second Bid Info
 - Wild Horse Commercial Kitchen Equipment: \$199,964.21
- HCCAA will purchase from the apparent low bidder, Wild Horse Commercial Kitchen Equipment, in the amount of amount of \$199,964.21.
