REPLACEMENT PUMPS (2) AT LIFT STATION #20

Background and Findings

- Constructed in 2009, Lift Station #20 is the largest lift station on the south side of the City of Killeen, located within the Trimmier Creek Basin. It operates with two submersible pumps.
 - Pumps are responsible for elevating wastewater from a lower to a higher elevation.
- □ With a rated capacity of 5.9 million gallons per day (MGD), it receives flow from a 15-inch gravity collection main and an 18-inch main fed by two other lift stations, making it a critical station within the system.
- In January 2025, staff advertised for a multi-year bid for pump replacements at twelve (12) lift stations and two (2) pump stations.
 - □ Lift Station #20 was on the list for replacement

- On March 18, 2025, City Council approved the rejection of the one (1) response to bid 25-16, Multi-Pump Replacements.
 - Review of the one (1) response showed that specifications in the bid packet were not quoted as specified.
- On March 19, 2025, Water & Sewer received a quote for replacement and installation of two (2) submersible pumps at Lift Station #20 from Pump Solutions, Inc. in the amount of \$123,000, utilizing their contract through The Interlocal Purchasing System (TIPS).





City Council authorize the City Manager, or designee, to execute a letter of agreement with Pump Solutions, Inc. utilizing purchasing cooperative TIPS contract #23010401, in the amount of \$123,000 and authorize the City Manager, or designee to execute any and all change orders within the amounts set by State and Local law.
