Background

2

- Staff submitted an application to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) for an Airport Improvement Program (AIP) grant
- This project is on our previously approved FAA Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) for FY21

Background

3

- The grant is for the replacement of Perimeter Fencing at Killeen-Fort Hood Regional Airport (KFHRA)
- Project includes new fencing and associated gate components and replacement of electronic locking devices and automated gates

Discussion

4

- FAA has offered the City an AIP Grant in the amount of \$136,500 for this project
- Typically, all AIP grants require 10% match, which is usually met with Passenger Facility Charge (PFC) funds

Discussion

5

- The American Rescue Plan Act signed into law on March 11, 2021, provides funds to increase the federal share to 100 percent for AIP grants already planned for fiscal year 2021
- No impact to Airport operating fund

Recommendation

- City Council accept the Federal Aviation Administration AIP grant in the amount of \$136,500 and authorize the City Manager or designee to execute all grant documents and any and all amendments or actions within the amounts set by federal, state and local law
