**SUBJECT: SHEILA DRIVE NAME CHANGE REQUEST**

Honorable Mayor and City Council,

Lowes Boulevard is a public street that runs east to west from South W.S. Young Drive to West Trimmier Road and is classified as a collector road on the City's current Thoroughfare Plan.

The construction of an extension for Lowes Boulevard from West Trimmier Road to Florence Road was identified in a prioritized list of road projects. On September 21, 2010, the City Council authorized CCM/R 10-105R expressing intent to reimburse advanced funding from the General Fund for the project. The bulk of the Lowes Boulevard design is currently being reviewed by TxDOT as part of the upcoming Trimmier Road Widening Project.

A portion of the proposed Lowes Boulevard Extension implicates a platted, yet undeveloped right-of-way, currently named "Sheila Drive." The Public Works Department-Transportation Division is requesting a name change from "Sheila Drive" to "Lowes Boulevard." In accordance with Section 25-118(1) of the City of Killeen's Code of Ordinances, the reason for the name change request is to establish continuity of a street name. This change will reduce confusion with regard to street naming convention and will also reinforce the notion that Lowes Boulevard is a major east-west collector.
