
## ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A TEMPORARY SPEED LIMIT ALONG HWY-195

## Background

- TXDOT is currently installing median barriers along Highway 195
  (Fort Hood Street) as a safety project.
- TXDOT recently informed the city that the second phase of construction will begin late summer of 2025.
- TXDOT informed the City that for this phase, they are requesting a reduction in speed through the construction limits.
- TXDOT will be making the request through their commission and requesting support from the City of Killeen.

## Background

- The ordinance will establish a reduced speed limit of 55 mph through the construction zone.
- The ordinance will allow the Killeen Police to enforce the reduced speed limit.
- The estimated time of construction begins August 1, 2025, and extends to March 31, 2026. Upon completion of the project the speed limit will then return to 70 mph.

## Recommendation

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt the Ordinance as presented to temporarily reduce the speed limit along the construction limits of Highway 195 (South Fort Hood Street) to 55 mph.
