Background

- Staff submitted an application to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) for an Airport Improvement Program (AIP) grant
- This grant is for the runway pavement maintenance project to include rubber removal, crack sealing, marking and minor repairs and is on our previously approved FAA Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) for FY21

Discussion

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- FAA has offered the City an AIP Grant in the amount of \$50,000 for this project
- Typically, all AIP grants require 10% match, which is usually met with Passenger Facility Charge (PFC) funds

Discussion

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- The American Rescue Plan Act signed into law on March 11, 2021, provides funds to increase the federal share to 100 percent for AIP grants already planned for fiscal year 2021
- No impact to Airport operating fund

Alternatives

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- Do not accept the grant
- Accept the grant

Recommendation

- City Council accept the Federal Aviation Administration AIP grant and authorize the City Manager or designee to execute all grant documents and any and all amendments or actions within the amounts set by federal, state and local law
