Background and Findings

- ❑ The 2025 Water and Wastewater Master Plan includes Project 1S – Rehabilitation and Expansion of Lift Station No. 6, located at 3816 Water St.
- ❑ Lift Station No. 6, built in 2001, is in great need of rehab and will be expanded from a firm pumping capacity of 17 million gallons per day (MGD) to 24 MGD.
- ❑ This lift station, which primarily serves the northeastern part of the city, is the largest and most critical lift station in the city's sewer collection system.
