Background

- City Council approved a grant program for nonprofit organizations in the amount of \$150,000 utilizing American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds
 - ▣ Application process was open for submissions April 13 – May 12, 2022
- On May 18, 2022, City Council selected six applicants to receive funding
 - ▣ Fifteen applications were received
- In accordance with state law, City Council must declare a public purpose for the expenditure of funds
 - ▣ Services directed at low to moderate income residents, residents disproportionately impacted, or located in a Qualified Census Tract
 - ▣ Use must directly address a negative impact of the pandemic
 - ▣ Use must be proportional to amount of impact

Selected Applicants

3

- Six applications were selected to be funded for \$10,000 each:
 1. DaZona Life and Learning
 2. The Greater Killeen Free Clinic
 3. Unity Visitation Center
 4. Operation Phantom Support
 5. Variety the Children's Charity of Texas
 6. The Academy of Exceptional Learners

Alternatives Considered

- Do not approve the funding for the six nonprofit organizations
- Amend the selected organizations
- Approve the funding for the six nonprofit youth organizations, declare the public purpose and authorize staff to execute grant agreements for each organization
