Background

- City Council approved a grant program for nonprofit organizations in the amount of \$150,000 utilizing American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds
 - Application process was open for submissions April 13 May 12, 2022
- On May 18, 2022, City Council selected six applicants to receive funding
 - Fifteen applications were received
- In accordance with state law, City Council must declare a public purpose for the expenditure of funds
 - Services directed at low to moderate income residents, residents disproportionately impacted, or located in a Qualified Census Tract
 - Use must directly address a negative impact of the pandemic
 - Use must be proportional to amount of impact

Selected Applicants

- Six applications were selected to be funded for \$10,000 each:
 - 1. DaZona Life and Learning
 - 2. The Greater Killeen Free Clinic
 - 3. Unity Visitation Center
 - 4. Operation Phantom Support
 - 5. Variety the Children's Charity of Texas
 - 6. The Academy of Exceptional Learners
