## BID NO. 19-16: SOUTH WATER SUPPLY, PH. 1

February *5*, 2019

## Background

- Bell County Water Control and Improvements District No. 1 (WCID No. 1) is currently building a new water treatment plant at Stillhouse Hollow Lake along with a large transmission water main to deliver 10 MGD of treated water to the City of Killeen (City). This project has an estimated completion date of Spring 2020.
- WCID No. 1 water transmission main will end near the intersection of Trimmier and Chaparral.

- South Water Supply, Phase 1: approximately 3,000 linear feet of 20-inch water line pipe along the South side of Chaparral Road to connect to the City's water system.
- On January 16, 2019, bids for construction of the SWS Phase 1: Lower Pressure Plane Water Main were opened and read aloud. Five (5) contractors submitted bids on this project.
- □ Gary W. Purser Construction, Ltd. was the low bidder at \$562,676.

- Reject all bids and rebid the project
- □ Reject all bids and hold the project.
- Award a contract to the lowest responsive/responsible bidder, Gary W. Purser Construction, Ltd.

- □ Staff recommends that the City Council authorize the City Manager, or designee, to enter into an agreement with Gary W. Purser Construction, Ltd. for a contract to construct the South Water Supply Project, Phase 1: Lower Pressure Plane Water Main in the amount of \$562,676.
- Staff recommends that the City Manager, or designee, be expressly authorized to execute any and all changes to this contract within the amounts set by state and local law.
