

TERM LIMITS AMENDMENT

OR-21-022 December 7, 2021

- In the annual review of the Governing Standards and Expectations, the City Council discussed changing the term limits for members of boards, commissions and committees. That change was not made.
- Such a change to the Governing Standards would also require a change to Chapter 2, Administration.
- A motion of direction was approved on September 28, 2021, to delay the question until the second meeting of December.

- Current
 - Not more than 6 consecutive years
- Proposed change
 - Not more than 2 consecutive terms

Term Limits

□ Terms vary from 1 to 3 years, with most being 2 years

- The exception to extend beyond the limits is not affected:
 - If a particular position requires specialized knowledge, licenses or certification and no other qualified and interested person is available, or
 - For other good cause found by the Council.

- □ The City Council may:
 - Leave the current ordinance in place

OR

Approve an amendment to Chapter 2 changing the terms limits.

Based on the previous motion of direction by the City Council, Staff recommends approval of this ordinance amendment.
