

Background

- The Transportation Division maintains 539 centerline miles (2,191 lane miles) of paved roadways within the City
- There was 56 lane miles that received milling, overlay, and striping in FY21
- □ September 14, 2021, Ordinance No. 21-055 was amended to increase the street maintenance fee
 - \$4.3M annually for pavement maintenance
 - \$4.0M annually for cash funded street reconstruction
 - \$1.6M annually to repay a \$24M bond issue for street reconstruction

Background Cont.

- There are various types of street maintenance performed on the City roadways
 - Milling and Overlay
 - HA5 High Density Mineral Bond
 - Slurry Seal
 - Pavement Markings
 - Crackseal



- Reject projected allocation of FY22 Street
 Maintenance Funds
- Authorize the allocation of FY22 Street Maintenance Funds

 Staff recommends that the City Council authorize the allocation of the FY22 street maintenance fund;
 allowing Transportation to proceed with needed repairs
