KILLEEN SOLID WASTE ROUTEWARE AGREEMENT

Background

- Prior to 2015 the City used a paper-based map system for routes.
- In 2015, the City began using Routeware to optimize its solid waste pickup routes, which:
 - Allows solid waste trucks to track the addresses that have been serviced or that need to be serviced.
 - Allows the driver to take pictures and records date & time for missed service or additional charges.
 - Provides customer service reps with access to the driver's routes with live updates.

Background Cont.

- Routeware GPS system increases driver productivity,
 accountability, and safety, all while helping to reduce costs.
- □ The annual product maintenance agreement costs are:
 - □ FY 22 \$61,000
 - □ FY 23 \$65,000
 - □ FY 24 \$70,000
 - Total \$196,000

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- Search for a different software/hardware provider.
- Choose not to execute the addendum; returning the division to paper-based routing methods.
- Authorize execution of Routeware, Inc. support addendum for a period of three (3) years; January 1, 2022, to December 31, 2024.

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Staff recommends that City Council authorize the City Manager, or designee, to execute the Routeware, Inc., Support Addendum for services from January 1, 2022, to December 31, 2024; using the full allocation of funds in the annual Solid Waste budget.
