

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KILLEEN, TEXAS, REAPPOINTING THE PRESIDING MUNICIPAL JUDGE TO A FOUR-YEAR TERM; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Texas Government Code sec. 30.00006(b) provides that the governing body shall by ordinance appoint its municipal judge; and

WHEREAS, Texas Government Code sec. 30.00006(d) provides that the governing body shall by ordinance establish the term of office of its municipal judges as either two or four years; and

WHEREAS, The City of Killeen's Charter, sec. 32, establishes that the term of the Municipal Judge shall be four years;

WHEREAS, the City Council discussed the reappointment of the Presiding Municipal Judge, Mr. Mark D. Kimball, at its February 6, 2018 workshop and reached the consensus that he should be reappointed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KILLEEN:

SECTION I. That the Presiding Municipal Judge, Mr. Mark D. Kimball, is hereby reappointed to a four-year term.

SECTION II. That should any section or part of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, it shall not invalidate or impair the validity, force, or effect of any other section or parts of this ordinance.

SECTION III. That all ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION IV. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage of the ordinance.
