

KILLEEN ARTS COMMISSION BOARD REDUCTION

Arts Commission Background

- The Arts Commission promotes the arts and cultural enrichment in the city.
- □ Current Board Structure 11 members
 - Three representatives of the major art forms:
 - Instrumental and vocal music, radio, television, tape, and sound recording;
 - Dance, drama, motion pictures, and creative writing; and
 - Folk art, painting, sculpture, photography, graphic and craft arts, architecture, design, and allied fields.
 - Educator with a background in the arts.
 - Seven (7) members of the public-at-large.

Arts Commission Background, cont.

- Arts Commission Board history
 - Prior to October 2004 9 member board.
 - October 2004 11 member board.
 - October 2005 13 member board.
 - September 2006 11 member board.
- Arts Commission recommend changes
 - On September 8, 2017, the Arts Commission voted to reduce board members by two public-at-large positions.
 - No impact to current board members.
 - One position is held by a member whose term expires September 30, 2018.
 - The other position is held by John Miller, who is eligible to move to the vacant folk art, painting, etc. major art form position.

Recommendation

- Staff recommends that City Council approve the ordinance reducing the Killeen Arts Commission Board by two public-at-large positions.
- Staff also recommends that City Council approve the resolution amending the Arts Commission Rules and Regulations reflecting the reduction in board members from 11 to 9.
