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- Current Council Chambers built in 1995
- City Council approved funding for reconstruction project with adoption of FY 18 Budget
- Construction contract awarded July 10
- RFP No. 18-20 Council Chambers Technology Project issued July 15
 - City sought best value from an experienced vendor to design and install modern meeting production technology and equipment to complement reconstructed City Council Chambers
- One proposal received July 30 from RUSHWORKS in the amount of \$143,821

Project Highlights

Major goals:

- Provide an excellent user and viewer experience
- Update all sound, video and display equipment
- Add modern meeting management controls
- Integrate new technology with existing systems
- Ensure compliance with accessibility standards
- Installation will be coordinated with construction timeline
- Project will be fully funded with PEG Funds pending budget amendment
- Highly qualified vendor with extensive experience, excellent references and successful performance record with the City of Killeen

Alternatives Considered

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 - 1. Award contract to RUSHWORKS
 - 2. Issue a new RFP to solicit different vendors
- □ Staff recommends alternative No. 1
 - Staff determined that RUSHWORKS offers an excellent solution for our project, is well qualified to complete it and has a successful performance record with previous projects
