JOINT ELECTION AGREEMENTS WITH KISD AND CTC

- The City of Killeen, KISD and CTC will hold elections on May 4th
- School districts are required to hold joint elections with city or county (EC 11.0581)
- State law requires a joint election agreement laying out each entity's responsibility and costs
- Separate agreements for early voting and election day

- Voter convenience voters cast ballots for all elections at one location; and
- Reduces the election costs for each entity

- Election expenses initially paid by the city
- KISD and CTC will reimburse the city for one-third of shared election costs
- Should KISD or CTC not hold an election, costs would be split evenly between the remaining entities
- □ Election cost is approximately \$68,000

Staff recommends City Council approve the Early Voting and Election Day joint election agreements with KISD and CTC and authorize the City Manager, or designee, to enter into the agreements.
