MOU Background

2

- The Killeen Independent School District (KISD) Police Department and the Killeen Police Department have operated under an MOU for several years.
- The current agreement was signed in 2006. There are no substantive changes; however, there are new signatories.

MOU Overview

3

- The Killeen Independent School District (KISD) Police Department has primary jurisdiction for supplying police services on all property under their control, during school hours and events, excluding offenses involving employees.
- Killeen PD will file reports during non-school hours and forward to KISD PD for investigation, when available.

MOU Overview continued

4

- Both parties agree to concurrent jurisdiction within 1000 feet.
- The agreement renews automatically each year up to five years.
- Both parties may agree to revise or either party may terminate the agreement in writing at any time.
- There are no expenditures for entering into this agreement.

Alternatives

5

- ❑ Participate in and sign the Memorandum of Understanding with the Killeen Independent School District Police Department.
- ❑ Choose to not participate in the Memorandum of Understanding.

Recommendation

6

- Staff recommends the City Council approve the Memorandum of Understanding with the Killeen Independent School District Police Department and authorize the City Manager or his designee to execute the agreement.
