MOU Background

- Texas A&M University-Central Texas (TAMUCT) Police
 Department and the Killeen Police Department are currently operating under a Memorandum of Understanding.
- There are no substantial changes; updated signatories.
- MOU clarifies procedures for mutual aid, communications and operations.

- TAMUCT Police Department has primary jurisdiction for supplying police services on all property under their control, excluding leased property on Trimmier.
- TAMUCT PD and Killeen PD agree to procedures to request aid, radio communications, assist with major investigations and incidents requiring a tactical response, jail procedures, etc.

- The agreement renews automatically each year up to five years.
- Both parties may agree to revise or either party may terminate the agreement in writing at any time.
- There are no expenditures for entering into this agreement.

- Participate in and sign the Memorandum of Understanding with Texas A&M University-Central Texas Police Department.
- Choose to not participate in the Memorandum of Understanding.

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Council approve the Memorandum of Understanding with Texas A&M University-Central Texas Police Department and authorize the City Manager or his designee to execute the agreement.
