City Policy On Annexing/Accepting Voluntarily Annexed and Donated Land, Water Lines, Sewage Lines and Drainage Lines

Description of Problem/Issue/Idea:

In lieu of recent and past problems regarding issues with road and street quality, along with problems involving water related lines that have varied over the years, the purpose of my agenda item proposal is to set a minimal limit of 2-3 years before the city of Killeen will accept a voluntary annexation proposal from or for any new, or pre-existing development, road, street or any type of water lines in general. This timeline will not begin until the said items to be donated have been wholly, and firmly established after the total build out and, or insertion of 100% of the structures and items to be donated and, or annexed by the City of Killeen, Tx. In doing this, the City of Killeen will guard its its taxpayers pocket books by increasing the level of assurance that the said annexed properties or received donations have been built to a high standard that will not cost the citizens money more sooner than later.

Requested Action:

My requested action is for the city council to provide a motion of direction to our City Manager and staff by first, approving to move the item forward for a full discussion and secondly, after that discussion, directing our CM and staff to draft up the policy revision for a full review and, hopefully, passage by the city council.
