

Background

- Curbside recycling service offered from July 2000 to September 2016
 - City Council voted to discontinue due to amount of use
- Current recycling drop off locations: Killeen Recycling Center and Transfer Station
- □ Recycling trailers offer a cost effective, convenient alternative
 - Locations currently benefiting from use of recycling trailers are Nolanville and Fort Hood
- Received one bid from Pro-Tainer, Inc. in the amount of \$60,006 for three (3) recycling trailers


Recycling Trailers







- Provide additional drop off capability at current City facilities and local areas.
- Create an environment to promote better recycling practices within the City and during special events.
- Allow first hand recycling experience during educational programs at schools and community events.
- Reduce waste transported to the landfill which reduces harmful emissions from being released into the atmosphere.
- Reduction in transportation costs for waste if recycling is made more convenient.



Alternatives

- Continue offering the two (2) current recycling drop off locations only; Killeen Recycling Center and Transfer Station.
- Direct City Staff to pursue other recycling options.
- Authorize the purchase of three (3) recycling trailers from Pro-Tainer, Inc. City as additional recycling drop off locations as proposed.
 - Funding is available in FY 19 budget

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the City Council authorize the City Manager or his designee to execute a contract for the procurement of three (3) recycling trailers from Pro-Tainer, Inc. and further authorize the City Manager or designee to execute any change orders in compliance with state law and city policy.
