Background

- ❑ The Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriation (CRRSA) Act was signed into law on December 27, 2020
- ❑ \$2 Billion awarded to U.S. Airports
- ❑ FAA has offered the City a \$1,758,480 grant to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the COVID-19 pandemic at Killeen-Fort Hood Regional Airport (KFHRA)
- ❑ FAA has also offered the City an Addendum to this grant for \$37,830 for Concession Relief at KFHRA

Discussion

- ❑ CRRSA Act Airport Grant can only be used for costs related to operations, personnel, cleaning, sanitization, janitorial services, combating the spread of pathogens, and debt service payments
- ❑ CRRSA Addendum for Concessions Relief can only be used for providing relief from rent and minimum annual guarantees for eligible airport concessions
